

EJGC Planting areas

Hill Road

24th May 2022

Hill Road is a largely south-facing slope between the avenue and houses / a horse field. It is intended to be a shrubby thicket with some small trees.

Assumed: a gentle but low level of looking-after available for this space, and therefore that shrubs can be planted at 1.5 metre spacings (~200 per space), to create a dense thicket.

HR10	175 damson, 5 wild pear
HR11	175 bullace, 5 Xanthoceras sorbifolium
HR12	150 blackthorn, 25 hawthorn, 1 wild pear, 2 roses, 2 hops
HR13	150 blackthorn, 25 buckthorn, 3 whitebeam, 2 holly
